NOTE:

- ALL persons requesting a pass will be subject to vetting a records check through the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) Interstate Identification Index (III) is the minimum baseline background check for entrance onto Army Installations for non-CAC holders to include entrance of visitors and contractors. Vetting is to grant access and does grant the right to work, the government agent (COR) must coordinate with the anti-terrorism officer and the installation security manager for clearance for the contractors/vendors to perform services.
- 2. Persons who do not pass the security vetting will be denied access and provided with the process for submitting an appeal. The appeal process is governed by Army Directive 2014-05 and is non-waiverable. The appeal process can take an extended period of time.
- 3. Visitor Center or Physical Security staff may contact a Company POC listed on the access request form to verify that the request for a pass is valid.
- 4. All information on the access request form must be completed. The completed form and the verification documents listed above are to be presented to Visitor Center Staff or Physical Security Office. Access request forms may be emailed to: usarmy.hunterliggett.imcom-pacific.mbx.des-sec-and-acc-req@mail.mil
- 5. Any conduct which is detrimental to the maintenance of good order and discipline on the Fort Hunter Liggett/Parks RFTA Military Installation may result in confiscation of the visitor pass/badge, immediate removal from the installation, and the imposition of a BAR.
- 6. The Government Agent (sponsor) has overall responsibility for the conduct of the pass holder at all times while they are on the Installation. While this does not include punitive liability, the Agent may be required to brief senior installation leaders regarding acts of employee misconduct.
- 7. Pass holders will confine themselves only to those areas related to issuance of the pass. Pass holders will not enter any marked, restricted and/or controlled areas. Specifically airfields, command headquarters, motor pools, military training facilities, military barracks, housing areas other than those where you are an invited guest, areas where military weapons are present, fire stations, and communications facilities. Be prepared to identify yourself and the purpose of your presence on FHL/PRFTA to police or security personnel at all times.
- 8. Vehicles and packages at any time while on the installation.
- 9. Firearms and other personal weapons are prohibited except for specific sporting activities.
- 10. Any firearm brought onto FHL/PRFTA property for a legitimate activity is required to be registered with the Directorate of Emergency Services /Provost Marshal Office.
- 11. Concealed weapons permits are not valid on the installation.
